

## Remote Mobile Data Terminal System (RMDTS)



The State of Maryland is in the final stages of full implementation of the new Maryland criminal justice information system (Md CJIS). The antiquated Maryland Inter-Agency Law Enforcement System (MILES) is being replaced by a new Maryland Electronic Telecommunications Enforcement Resource System (METERS), which also includes a new RMDTS interface. In order to access RMDTS all Maryland law enforcement agencies with mobile computers had to be transitioned over the new interface. We are pleased to report that all agencies using CapWIN have been transitioned and are now operational. As new agencies join CapWIN they are being placed directly onto the RMDTS at the time of activation.

## Mobile Client Security



Over the past several months a few of our subscribing agencies have undergone and/or completed a Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) National Crime Information Center (NCIC) audit. One aspect of the audit process involved an examination of security procedures. CapWIN meets or exceeds all federal and state requirements. The CapWIN mobile client has been certified to meet the Federal Information Processing Standard (FIPSecure) 140.2. In addition, our network architecture diagrams were provided and no issues were identified regarding the mobile Criminal Justice Information System (CJIS) access.

## Victim Information and Notification Everyday Protective Orders



The Victim Information and Notification Everyday (VINE) program is a nationwide initiative to assist domestic violence victims. Last fall the State of Maryland expanded their participation in the VINE program to include victim updates. The VINE Protective Order (VPO) system provides victims a mechanism for registering to receive updates. One portion of this system requires law enforcement officers (LEOs) to update the appropriate Maryland Electronic Telecommunications Enforcement Resource System (METERS) database within two hours of their serving a VPO. This mandate was causing certain logistical difficulties for some agencies throughout the state. To address this issue

CapWIN developed a new VPO screen for our Maryland subscribers. The new screen provides a live mobile interface directly into METERS and allows officers to meet the mandated timeframe while still in the patrol vehicle. We are pleased to announce that the system is now live and in production.

System. CapWIN is excited to announce that we will be providing the mobile interface to the Statewide InterAct



Public Safety CAD System. This project is designed to provide mobile dispatch information to the Maryland State Police, the Maryland Transportation Authority

Police, the Maryland Transit Administration, and the Natural Resources Police Department. An official project kick-off meeting was held on April 14<sup>th</sup> at the Maryland State Police Headquarters and CapWIN was present for this event. We are looking forward to working with our state partners on this initiative and are confident that we will provide a superb mobile interface for all involved Maryland agencies.
